## **Rancho Bernardo Office Undamaged**

“Seventy percent of our employees evacuated during the fires,” said Laszlo Zoltan, Vice President of Sales for DVEO, the broadcast division of Computer Modules. “However, we have now shipped all temporarily delayed orders to our customers. We are happy that everyone is safe, but we are saddened by the many losses,

especially in our neighborhood. We are supporting relief and re-building efforts by making a donation to a local family whose home was lost to the fire.”
